4 Attend BPS Showcase of Schools on December 14 at Boston Latin Academy. This is an opportunity to check out all BPS schools under one roof.



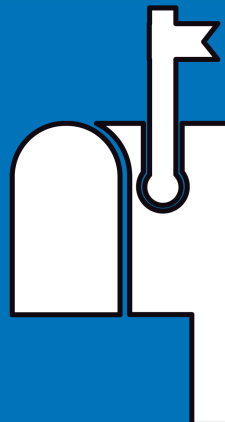
5 Late-December it is time to pre-register www.sis.mybps.org and schedule an appointment. Remember you must visit a Welcome Center to complete your registration process

DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST

Bring These Documents to the Welcome Center to Register

1. Parent photo identification
2. Child's original birth certificate (or, if necessary, passport or I-94)
3. Child's up-to-date immunization record
4. Two proofs of Residency in Boston



Proof of Residency: two of these printed with the name and current address of the student's parent/guardian:dated within the past 60 days

- A utility bill (cannot be a water or cell phone bill)
- A current lease, Section 8 agreement, or BPS residency affidavit, dated within a year
- A deed or a mortgage statement, or a property tax bill dated within the last year
- A W2 form dated within the year, or a payroll stub
- A letter from an approved government agency
- A bank or credit card statement
